said Washington Township Kosciusko county Indiana

I also I want my said son Scott W. Eddy to have
forty five dollars owing to me by Charles Mc Lorie
which is to be paid in ^{first quality of} lumber delivered here at nine
dollars per thousand. And I ^{also} want by said son Scott
W Eddy to have all my household goods when my
said wife is done with them
