

# Peter Wassenaar

Pete Wassenaar, 87, died Sunday at 1:30 a.m. at Santa Rosa hospital, where he had been ill for the past two months.

Mr. Wassenaar was a native of Holland and the husband of Mary Wassenaar. The couple had been living in that city since Mr. Wassenaar became ill a few months ago. Prior to that they had lived in Petaluma since 1946.

Mr. Wassenaar came to the United States at the age of 19 and lived in Iowa, South Dakota and Sacramento until 1936 when he moved to Santa Rosa.

Both Mr. and Mrs. Wassenaar were members of the Golden Age Club.
